Microsoft has come out with a new browser for Windows 7, 8.1 and Windows 10. This gets installed automatically. If you are seeing issues with drop down menus not working such as account codes then you need to set the Compatibility Settings.

To set the Compatibility Settings in Windows Explorer 11 for Windows 7, 8.1 and Windows 10 open your internet browser and click on the Help Menu. If you do not see the Menu at the top of your browser. You can also go to the Gear Icon in the upper left corner of your browser and get to compatibility view settings also.
