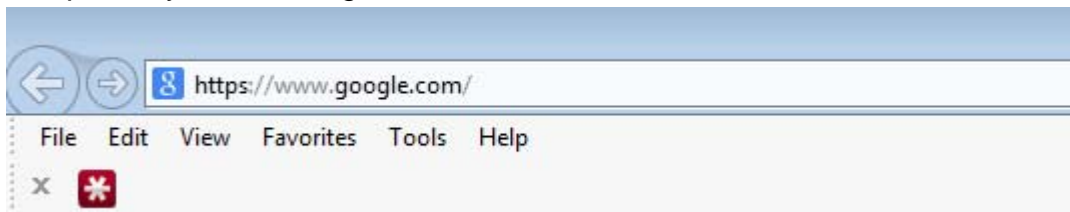
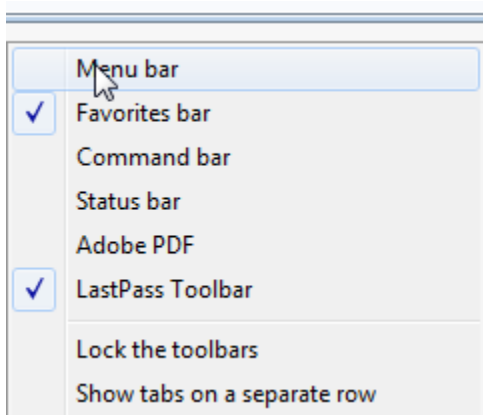

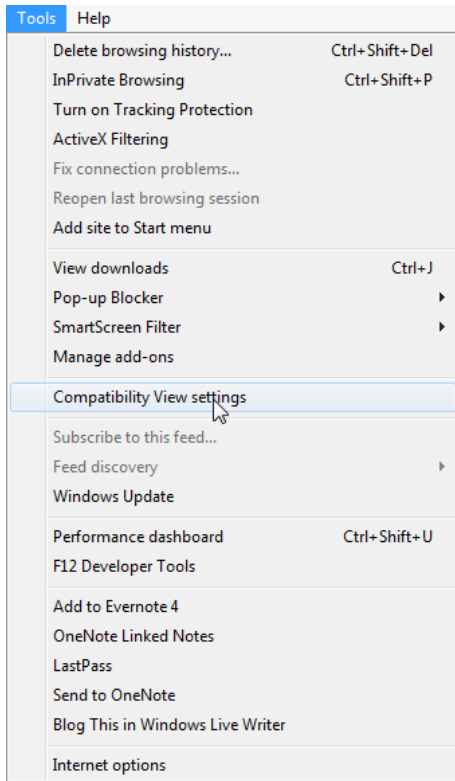
To set the Compatibility Settings in Windows Explorer 11 for Windows 7, 8.1 and Windows 10 open your internet browser and click on the Help Menu. If you do not see the Menu at the top of your browser. You can also go to the Gear Icon in the upper left corner of your browser and get to compatibility view settings also.



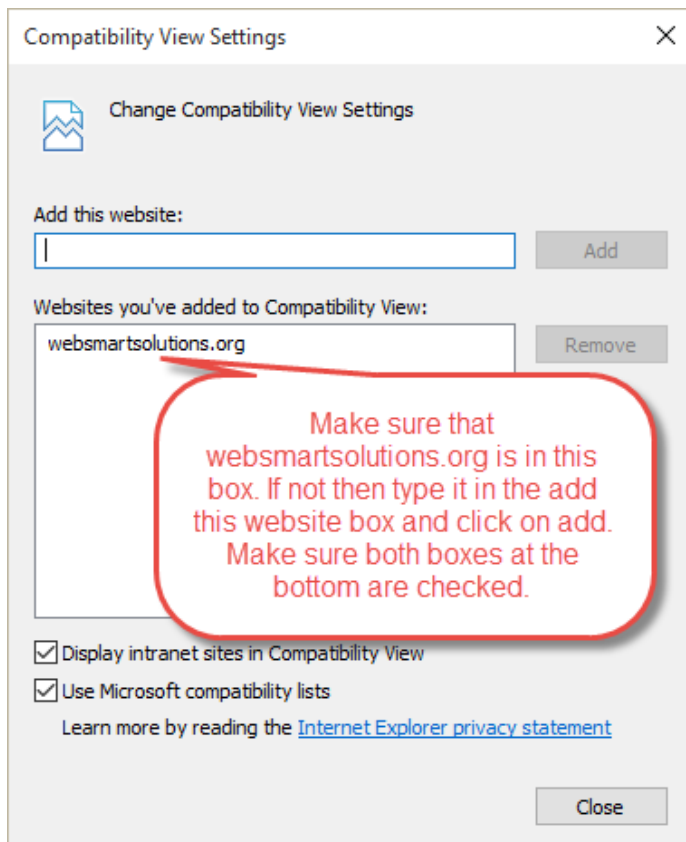
Then right click under the URL and select Menu from the drop down and that will put the Menu at the top.



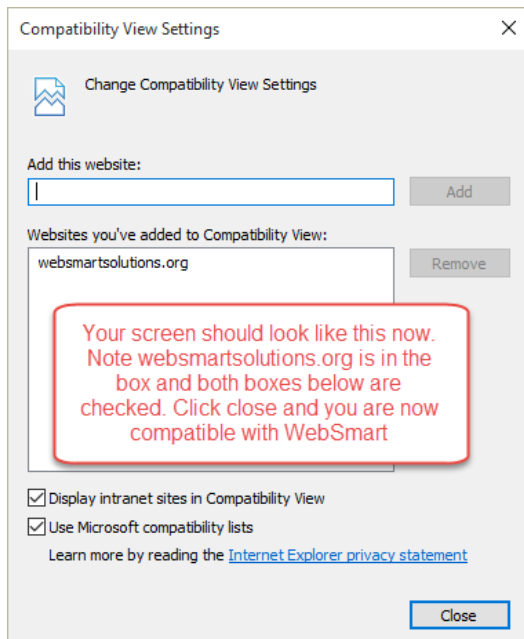
Now go to Tools and down to Compatibility View Settings.
